Internship | Assistant concerts Musical Instruments Museum (MIM)– RMAH

The MIM, part of the Royal Museums for Art and History (RMAH), is a museum where musical instruments are preserved, researched and displayed to the public. Some 1200 pieces are exhibited on 4 floors, each offering a different perspective: a chronological trail from music in Ancient Egypt to instruments of the 19th century, a room dedicated to keyboards, a floor dedicated to traditional music all worldwide and a collection focusing on mechanical, electric and electronic instruments.

The museum is housed on the Old England building on the Mont des Arts or Kunstberg, a captivating architectural setting composed of a neoclassical mansion, a steel structure of Saintenoy and a new construction in the Villa Hermosa street.

Live music has been part of the DNA of the institution since the start. The museum houses a modest but good concert hall where since 2021 music is being played again. The hall offers a stage for up-and-coming talent on the one hand and established names in the music landscape on the other, in close collaboration with our partners and conservatories from Brussels. To support the team, we are searching for an intern who can help set up and supervise the concerts.

Are you a music enthusiast looking for experience that we are looking for? Are you regularly available between September and June on Sundays and eventually on Thursdays and eager to get started in the museum and/or musical sector? Then we would love to hear/read from you!

Description of the function and tasks

You will work closely with the Public and Education team that is responsible for the concerts at the MIM. You are willing to learn how to work in the museum and to ensure that the activities in the concert hall run smoothly across all departments (reception, education, communication, security).

You are regularly available from October to June, during the weekends and 1 to 3 weekdays.

Specifically, you are responsible for

- logistic support of the concerts and other activities in the concert hall
- receiving and guiding organizers and musicians before, during and after the concerts/activities
