(Documents referring to the applicant's means of living during his/her stay in Germany. (e.g.: a document about the scholarship of the trainee, the scholarship amount and period of the scholarship.)

O Visa Appointment and Visa Documents

Update of your visa appointment and visa status on 14-day intervals.
