Ekkisens hosts at least one exhibition every month. Director Freyja Eilíf manages various other art projects travelling exhibitions and residencies.



She is an active independant artist and curator and has a worskhop studio place joint to Ekkisens Art Space.

Erasmus interns from various backrounds are welcome! Artists, designers, writers, programmers, theorists, build workers, film workers, dancers, scientists!

Minimum of 2 month stay - you decide the MAX.


Interns at Ekkisens join Freyja Eilíf in her work at the studio, managing events at Ekkisens, supervising events the art space, installing work, bulding art work, assisting artists who are exhibiting at the space, watching over exhibitions and etc. etc.

Work is often flexible and never more than 6 hours a day, 3-4 days a week.
