

OUR SCHOOL:

The Official Schools of Languages in Spain have gained an excellent reputation over the years. They devote themselves to language teaching at different levels, from beginners to advanced, covering all MCRE (Common European Framework of Reference) A1, A2, B1, B2, C1 and C2.

The EOI Valencia has excellent facilities including free Internet access, a library, a lab, a computer lab, a cafeteria and a small area on each floor to sit and chat with other students or teachers. We also have a great number of interactive whiteboards. The school has 33 classrooms with multimedia facilities, overhead projector PC and audio-visual systems.

The library offers a free loan service with 24 computers online for students and language assistants.

The school is well served by buses and it is close to the centre, the universities and the beach.

OUR STUDENTS:

Most of our students come through personal motivation and study one or two languages annually. The languages taught are English, German, Italian, French, Spanish, Valencian, Portuguese, Russian, Arabic, Japanese, Greek, Basque and Chinese to more than 12.000 students each academic year. Oral practice is very important for our students as most of them are keen on learning as much as possible about European culture and European countries.

The school gives courses of 120 hours of classes from October to May twice a week and on a two-hour-lesson basis.

We have taken part in EU programs on several occasions, hosting Comenius Language Assistants from 2003 to 2013, and offering them the possibility to study Spanish at our school.

OUR TEACHERS:

More than 120 teachers are offered a number of technical and multimedia training programs. They are all deeply motivated in offering the best language teaching, as well as familiarizing their students with the cultural background of the countries involved. In this regard, the multicultural nature of this school becomes apparent in the great number of nationalities amongst both our teachers and students.

OUR CITY:

Valencia is the third largest city in Spain, a seaside town with a million inhabitants. It offers an extensive range of cultural and social events, and the school makes the most of them by encouraging students to fully benefit from them.
